





An Ombuds is a person trained in conflict resolution who is independent of SPSP and has no other role in the Society.

Organizations have found that people are often more willing to report concerns when an Ombuds is available, and SPSP is committed to improving reporting options for convention attendees. This service is confidential and a completely anonymized report will be provided to the leadership to summarize trends after the convention.

WHY WOULD I

To obtain advice and consultation regarding any concerns relating to fairness, equity, respect, or harassment that may arise during the convention.

The ombuds is available to listen to any concerns you may have regarding unwelcome behavior, including incidents and allegations of harassment.






Kathleen H. Canul is an ombudsperson and mediator currently serving several organizations as an annual meeting and organizational ombudsperson.


