

2024 Single Presenter Submission Guide: Posters, Research Spotlights, and Roundtable Unconferences

Presentation Types

There are three presentation types available for the later single presenter submission period due on September 14, 2023. You may only submit ONE submission to either the earlier submission period (Single presenter symposia OR Data Blitzes) or one of these listed below.

Posters (in-person only): Posters are the largest form of programming. Posters are grouped in sessions based on their keywords. All poster presenters will be required to submit a PDF of their poster electronically and an optional 5-minute video/audio recording. *Submissions due by Sept 14, 2023*

Research Spotlight (virtual only): These are recorded 2-minute on-demand video presentations. This will be offered for those that cannot attend in person but wish to share their research with attendees through the convention app before, during, and after the convention. *Submissions due by September 14, 2023*

Roundtable Unconference (in-person only): Pitch your ideas. Discuss lessons learned. Showcase best practices. Have a casual conversation about recent scientific issues. This format is ideal for someone who doesn't have data to present, but would like the opportunity to connect with colleagues and be included on the program. Roundtable unconferences are scheduled during two 70-minute sessions. There will be numbered tables in the room and you will be assigned a slot at a designated table. Attendees will be able to rotate among the tables to talk with all presenters. Submissions due by September 14, 2023
